### **Regular Board Meeting**

The meeting was called to order by Vice President Kurtis Wilcox at 7:00 p.m.

The minutes for the June 26, 2017 meeting were reviewed. Jim made a motion to approve the minutes. Levy seconded, and the minutes were approved unanimously.

#### Treasurer's Report – Mark reported our cash on hand, as of 7/21/2017 is \$461,454.48.

He also reported our status from Jan 1, 2017 to June 30, 2017 through 50% of the year income was 55.62% of budget, and expense was 49.16% of budget.

ESD 6 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter payment of \$244,612 has been deposited into the Schertz Bank.

### **Unfinished Business and General Orders**

**Fire Chief Report** – Chief Zipp reported that

- 1. We need to pray for rain, The Burn ban is in effect since July 6<sup>th</sup>, and conditions are very dangerous for a wild fire.
- 2. We assisted NBFD on a mulch fire in New Braunfels off Solms Rd. Four FDs responded along with NBFD at a site we had previously assisted on. This time everything went very smoothly and the fire was quickly put out.
- 3. We have 3 Firefighters at Texas A&M this week.
- 4. Chief Zipp met with the new Schertz FD Chief the previous Chief retired and his Assistant Chief was promoted.
- 5. We are trying to keep the fire fighters inside during the extreme heat, and will call for assistance if a fire breaks out to help relieve heat stressed fire fighters.

**Fire Marshal Report/ Emergency Rescue Report** – Bill Anz reported that in June we were very busy, we had 77 total calls, 31 fire related, 46 EMS/Rescue related. Our Avg. Response Time was 6:14 minutes for fire and 7:21 for EMS/Rescue.

### **Emergency Services District (ESD) Update** –Randy Maschek.

- 1. Randy introduced ESD6 Commissioner Frank Yannuzzi to the Board
- 2. ESD6 commissioners approved BVFD's Budget as submitted.
- 3. ESD6 commissioners responded to questions BVFD Board submitted regarding the transfer of property from BVD to ESD6.
  - A. They don't have problems with BVFD making purchases without ESD6 approval as long as the items are in the Budget.
  - B. BVFD can keep property purchased with non-ESD6 funds
  - C. ESD6 will pay all closing costs and associated fees related to the transfer of BVFD property to ESD6.

- 4. ESD 6 and Schertz EMS met with ESD 7 Chief Wren about Copper Ridge support. The chief referred them back to the Commissioners. Home owners are concerned over EMS response Times.
- 5. We are still looking for land.

# New Business

 Discuss and take action, if necessary, on contract and bill of sale to transfer station to ESD. Discussed ESD 6's agreement to BVFD Board requested, and found ESD 6 response to be acceptable. Member Levy Martinez made a motion that BVFD proceed with the transfer of all BVFD property to Comal County ESD 6, the motion was 2<sup>nd</sup> by Member Bob Schoeler. The vote passed unanimously.

Levy made a motion for the meeting to be adjourned, which was 2nd by Rick. Motion carried, and the meeting was adjourned at 7:43 p.m. Next meeting will be Aug. 28<sup>th</sup> @ 7PM.
