### Fire Chief Report – Chief Zipp reported that

- 1. We now have 11 full time employees and 16 part time employees. We have 11 apparatuses and cover 70-75 sq. miles.
- 2. We are still encouraging members to get address signs to aid us finding addresses.
- 3. The new BVFD web site is up and running.
- 4. In 2018 we will be working to open the new station on FM 1863.
- 5. We have been experiencing a normal work load.
- 6. We will be adding 6 new Full time employees for the new station.

**Fire Marshal Report**/ **Emergency Rescue Report** – Bill Anz reported that year our calls increased by 134 to 615 total. we had 615 total calls, 43 fire related, 403 EMS/Rescue related, and 169 other. Our Avg. Response Time was 7:56 minutes for fire and 7:50 for EMS/Rescue. We are starting Fire Prevention Month and plan to work with around 1000 kids at local schools and churchs.
