Regular Board Meeting

President Charles Flink called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. In addition to the BoD members above, Chief Zipp, Asst Chief Anz, Marilyn Winters (Bookkeeper), and Herb Coley, President, ESD 6 Commission were in attendance. Pledges of Allegiance to US Flag and Texas Flag were recited.

Minutes Approval – As the first order of business, minutes from the June 2021 meeting were presented. Marilyn Winters asked that Commissioner Haag's name spelling be corrected. With that change, Walter Brown made a motion to approve the minutes and Mark Schroeder seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report –Treasurer Mark Schroeder for the period Jan 1 to June 30th, 2021. As of July 23rd, 2021, cash on hand is \$655,221.07. As of June 30th, income was 50.32% of budget and expenses were 46.63.7% of budget through 50% of the year. Jim Moreland made a motion to approve the report and Bob Schoeler seconded. Unfinished Business and General Orders

- 1. Fire Chief Report Chief Zipp reported there is another Workmen's Comp claim going in for a firefighter that rolled his ankle on a call. Three firefighters are at A&M attending continuing education. BVFD participated in the Garden Ridge 4th of July parade. There are three firefighters signed up to go through swift water training in New Braunfels next month. There has been a minor increase in the number motor vehicle crashes.
- **2. Activity Report/ Emergency Rescue Report** In the report covering Jun 2021, Asst. Chief Anz's report outlined a total of 63 total runs; 17 fire and 46 rescue calls. Average emergency fire response time: 8:55 average rescue response time: 7:15. 10 calls were run out of the Delafield Station (Station 2). Report attached.
- 3. Emergency Services District (ESD) Update ESD 6 Commissioner President Herb Coley reported that ESD 6 has been working on an agreement with ESD 2 and 3 for the area that includes the west side of Hwy 46 which includes Copper Ridge and surrounding residences.

New Business

BoD Roundtable: President Flink said there are tentative plans to build a Quick Trip on the Northeast corner of the intersection of FM3009 and FM2252 (across from Capparelli's restaurant.) Nothing has been formalized; information only.
