Regular Board Meeting

President Charles Flink called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m. via ZOOM video conference. In addition to the BoD members above, Chief Zipp, Asst Chief Anz, and Marilyn Winters, Bookkeeper, were present.

Minutes Approval – As the first order of business, minutes of the Jan 2022 Meeting were presented. Kurtis Wilcox made a motion to approve and Rick Shimon seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report – President Flink reported on behalf of Treasurer Schroeder for the period Jan 1 to Jan, 31, 2022. As of Feb 23, cash on hand is \$420,686.51. As of Jan 31st, 2022, income was 25.1% of budget and expenses were 6.8% of budget through 8.3% of the year. Skip moved to accept, and Rick seconded. Passed unanimously.

- 1. Fire Chief Report Chief Zipp reported that BVFD is working on a water leak remediation at Station 2, and clearing out some trees lost from ice. BVFD is also trying to hire a couple of Firefighters, one of whom came highly recommended. BVFD is doing routine maintenance on trucks. Also holding CPR classes; Skip Courter and Eddie did another suicide prevention class at Triumphant Lutheran.
- 2. Activity Report/ Emergency Rescue Report Activity Report/ Emergency Rescue Report Asst Chief Anz reported. In his report covering Jan 1 to Jan31, 2022, Asst Chief Anz reported a total of 66 total runs; 17 fire and 49 rescue. Average emergency fire response time: 09:22. Average rescue response time: 6:54. 7 calls were run out of the Delafield Station (Station 2). Report attached.
